



## The Maple Table

What's up with the lemon curd ricotta pancakes and waffles? I've noticed this trend for a while now. I've thought about it, wanted to leap, but something was stopping me. Now I understand. If you like the lemon trend, you'll love *The Maple Tables'* Lemon Ricotta Pancakes. They're not for me, but overall, *The Maple Table* is a great choice for breakfast.

My daughter recently visited *The Maple Table* off of Main Street downtown Racine, and she loved it. I waited a little longer than I like for a greeting. Service is number one. The food could be terrible, and I'd go back for great service. The individual behind the hostess stand looked up and offered a hello. After quickly checking in with the hostess who was in the kitchen, they came back and promptly seated me. My server greeted me as they rushed by with another table's drinks and promised they would be right with me. Their trainee was shadowing and brought me a glass of water.

I ordered their Chocolate Macchiato with steamed whole milk and white chocolate. The description noted it would be drizzled with chocolate; instead, it had a butterscotch or caramel drizzle. Nevertheless, it was quite good.

In an effort to try something new, I ordered the Lemon Ricotta Pancakes topped with fresh berries and a berry compote. There was a bit too much compote, and it wasn't as thick and chunky as I had imagined. It was more of a jam than a compote. However, the berries were fresh, and that made it a winner.



The place is clean, friendly, and comfortable. It has the farmhouse style with a modern twist. They have a section on their menu that includes homemade donuts, with a house recipe, strawberry Nutella, maple goat cheese, and a donut of the month. I regret not trying the house recipe (cinnamon sugar and vodka raspberry jam). The prices are fair and reasonable.
